Relevance

In 2012, Burundi ranked on the 178th spot from 186 countries on the Human Development Index¹. According to the UNDP, Burundi has one of the lowest score in the Health index (0.487) standing on position 178 out of 186 countries². It also has one of the highest maternal mortality rates in the world: 800 per 100,000 live births (ranking at 179 out of 185 countries)³. It is tragic to see how preventable and treatable diseases represent an enormous health burden for poor people, particularly women and children, and make them suffer for a long time and/or die.

One of the main challenges, which the population faces, is inadequate provision of health care. Our major objective is to offer affordable quality health services to patients. Our goal is to incorporate many different facilities in order to provide patients with affordable adequate treatment within a multitude of services in one place. The clinic will contain the following sections and facilities:

- Pharmacy
- Laboratory
- Doctors' consulting rooms
- Out-patient department
- Maternity
- Delivery room
- Women wards
- Men wards
- Paediatrics
- Dentistry Stomatology
- Echography Gynaecology
- Ophthalmology
- Emergency unit
- Resuscitation/ Recovery room
- Neonatology
- · HIV/ AIDS and counselling unit
- Endoscopy
- · Radiology-Imaging
- Health education hall
- Rescue Ambulance service

With available medical equipments, we have a good start! However, we still have a long way to go! Consequently, we plan to start running the clinic with a minimum of services. A minimum of \$16,033.00 to purchase medications and \$20,000.00 to purchase more medical equipments and furniture and \$5,186.00 per month as staff reserve is still needed.

Prayer items:

- 1. Mbabazi clinic to be supplied with water, have a necessary minimum of medical equipments, medications, furniture and staff reserve;
- 2. Peace to be restored in Burundi.

We are open to partnership.
